

After the Government announced a huge drive to vaccinate against Covid-19 before January, there has been some confusion.

Here, we explain how to get your booster jab:



Vaccination services are working extremely hard to roll out the booster programme and to make as many appointments available as possible



The National Booking Service website is very busy but please keep checking. You may also be contacted by your local service or GP practice over the next few days about your vaccine

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You'll be able to have a booster 3 months from your 2nd vaccine. If it's been 2 months, you may want to book an appointment in preparation by using the Booking Service or calling 119



Appointments are being added daily and capacity is being increased. Keep trying the online booking system or call 119



Don't contact your GP practice about your booster vaccine. It's important to keep phones and online streams clear for patients with health-related needs



Unless you are contacted by your practice, GP practice appointments should be attended as planned. If anything changes, your practice will contact you



If you've tested positive to COVID, you'll need to wait 28 days before having your booster but you can book now.
