

Travelling safely to a Brighton COVID vaccination centre

If anyone is concerned about how they will travel safely to get a vaccine during lockdown, we can confirm that it is permissible to receive a lift from someone or use community transport providers offering this support for transport for medical appointments.

City Cabs of Brighton are offering **free** cab rides for Brighton residents to and from the Racecourse for patients to receive their COVID vaccine.

Anyone aged 80 and over currently qualifies for **free** travel with City Cabs and they are hoping to open this offer up to the over 70s.

Any patient who lives outside Brighton or who cannot access the vaccination site themselves and would rather not use public transport are being offered **discounted rates** for travel to the Racecourse with City Cabs if travelling within Brighton, or South Coast Taxis if travelling from outside Brighton.
